


- 1) Use fusible interfacing on front facing and back facing. Use an iron to fuse interfacing.
- 2) Sew front facing to back facing (shoulder seam).
- 3) Serge facing (front and back together).
- 4) Serge all other pieces. See details "A1".
- 5) Sew pockets upper hem (hand opening). See details "B"
- 6) Iron pocket seam allowance to the inside (follow notches on the pattern). See details "C".
- 7) Sew pockets on top of the front piece. See details "C1" (3 cm from lower hem and 3 cm from side seam)

8) Sew front to back (shoulder seam).

- 9) Sew sleeves to armholes (sleeve cup to open armhole. No side seams yet).
- 10) Sew side seam (both sleeve & body side-seam). Sew until side slit. See details "D".
- **11)** Iron **slits** open following lower notches on the pattern.
- 12) Before sewing slits, sew bottom hem. See details "G".
- 13) Sew slits. See details "F".
- 14) Sew sleeves hem. See details "E".
- 15) Sew facing to the neckline. See details "H1". Cut some notches, fold to the inside and lockstitch. See details "H2".
